The Domestic and Family Violence Service (SAVVDF in Catalan) is an interdisciplinary team of professionals with the purpose of offering a specialized resource to deal with all acts of violence (physical, sexual, psychological or economic) that take place within the family, at home, or with former partners regardless of having shared a house with the victim.

Domestic or family violence issues involve people with a disability that are abused by a family member or a care-taker, violence between siblings, violence between couples without a gender violence component, parental abuse by children, violence within LGTBIQ+ couples and men abused by their partner.
